COVID-19 PROTOCOL & RULES MODIFICATIONS

BEFORE YOUR ROUND

- You are not allowed out of your vehicle more than 30 minutes before your tee time
- You are required to follow the allotted times that you were given on your tee sheet. If you need to go to the washroom or get any refreshments prior to teeing off, you must work this into your allotted warm up time.
- Do not check in to the registration tent until it is your time to go to the 1st Tee
- Everyone will have a photo taken of them as they arrive to the first tee for our files.
- There will be no snips and no 50/50 at this time.
- Please ensure you have a pencil with you to keep score with prior to arriving at the first tee at your designated time.
- You will not be physically exchanging scorecards. Please read the "after your round" section for how we will be completing scoring.

DURING YOUR ROUND

- Do not touch anybody else's equipment or cart, and maintain 6ft physical distancing at all times.
- There will be no benches, ball washers, rakes, tee markers on course.
- Tees will be marked by coloured markers. You must follow regular rules of golf by not teeing off in front of the stakes, and within approximately 2 club lengths behind.
- Do not touch the flagstick.*see Rules Sheet for certain exceptions
- There are pool noodles in the hole low enough to allow your ball to sit on top of. The ball must stay in the hole for it to be considered holed.
- Ensure you smooth your own footprints in the bunkers after use.
- If there is inclement weather please take shelter in an on course shelter if there is one nearby, or make your way into the Clubhouse/Tournament Center if weather permits.
- You will be notified by horn if there is a stoppage in play. If you happen to be in a position where you may not hear the horn, please use logic and take cover if there is lightning in the area.

AFTER YOUR ROUND

- You will not be exchanging or signing scorecards.
 - You will be assigned someone to keep score for, as well as keep your own score as usual.
 - At the end of the round you will verbally verify your score as usual and once confirmed, you will then hold up the scorecard for scoring to take a picture of.
 - o Verbally read scores outloud to the scorer and then place the scorecard in the provided bin.
 - At this point your scorecard is considered returned.
- There will be no prize presentations or physical exchange of anything at this time. Scores will be posted on BlueGolf as they come in, and winners will be posted to social media with file photos taken on 1st tee.
